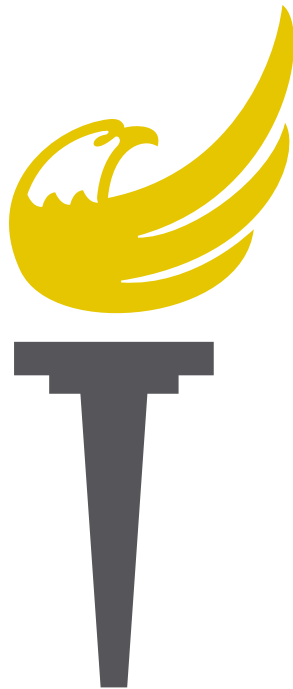

Appendix A

Resolution 03.2019-1: Membership Verification

Resolution of the Executive Committee of the Libertarian Party of Solano County for Membership Verification.

Where as, The Libertarian Party is the fastest growing political party in the State; having experienced registration growth which exceeds the overall voter growth,

Where as, The Republican Party and the Democratic Party continue to experience registered voter decline,

Where as, There is a growing risk of non-Libertarian voters attempting to misuse the Libertarian Party of our County to address non-Libertarian agendas,

Where as, The officers of the party must verify the authenticity and integrity of Central Committee Membership; now, therefore, be it

Resolved that the Libertarian Party of Solano County

1. Will revise its standing resolutions with a procedure to verify potential Central Committee Membership,
2. Will include in that document the exact language as follows:

--START--

All requests for Central Committee Membership must first be verified for compliance by the Treasurer and confirmed by at least one other "Officer" [Chair, Vice-Chair, or Secretary]. Verification must include the following:

1. Voter Registration Status must be a) Not registered to vote b) Registered as Libertarian or c) Registered as No Party Preference (NPP)
2. Verify applicant has agreed to the Non-Aggression Pledge
3. Verify applicant has confirmed they are a US Residence or a Permanent Resident Alien
4. Verify applicant is not already a member of the Libertarian Party of California
 - a. If already a member, verify which country they are affiliated with, and notify the state party Secretary, and county party Treasurer of affiliate change

The Treasurer shall take no longer than 30 days to verify this information and seat Central Committee Member within the county. If the Treasurer is unable to verify this information within 30 days, the application for Central Committee Membership is voided, and seated as a non-voting member.

We, the undersigned county Executive Committees of the Libertarian Party, hereby sign onto the following resolution:

Whereas, the Libertarian Party of California's Judicial Committee has ruled against a decision made by a quorum of delegates at the Libertarian Party of California Convention in 2019,

Whereas, the Libertarian Party of California's Judicial Committee has callously ignored the will of the membership body of the Libertarian Party of California,

Whereas, the Libertarian Party of California's Judicial Committee has been found to no longer represent the will of LPC members nor the best interests of the Party,

We, the undersigned county Executive Committees of the Libertarian Party hereby resolve to repudiate and refuse to recognize the decision of the Libertarian Party of California's Judicial Committee overturning the deletion of the previous Libertarian Party of California Platform.
